Did you know?

Contrary to popular belief, veterans do not automatically begin to receive benefits when their military service ends. Instead, they must apply for those benefits--a process that can be complicated and frustrating.

It is estimated that the **Veterans Administration currently has a backlog of up to 1.2 million claims.**

Veterans sometimes need help finding VA facilities, as well as managing the application process--and, if their claims are rejected, they might also need help filing appeals.

Unity Foundation Group provides needed support to help our nation's military personnel and their families make the transition to civilian life.
